#### Advocacy

- Invest in and fully deploy the resources necessary to increase access to Medical Nutrition Therapy.
- Continue to support the licensure compact to ensure practice across state lines.

### Member/Interprofessional Education

- Evaluate and enhance the Academy's Evidence Analysis Library through the lens of interprofessional collaboration and education.
- Determine what is needed to have Dietetics added as STEM field under the professional classification.

## Public Focus, Research and Media

- Work collaboratively with strategic partners to understand public opinions and perceptions.
- Launch a media campaign to position RDNs as the premier food and nutrition practitioners equipped to enhance the nutritional status of individuals and communities.
- Develop, expand and disseminate resources and research on emergent nutritional topics.


#### Organizational Barriers to Sustained Growth and Relevance
